Next Steps...

- 1. <u>Do you need to become a follower of Christ?</u> Admit your need (that you are a sinner, separated from God), believe Jesus is all you need to be forgiven of sin and reconciled to God forever, and confess Jesus as Lord and Savior (pray personally, and then make that known publicly through baptism).
- 2. Are you ready to go public as a follow of Jesus? Let's schedule a day to present you to the church to be welcomed as a part of the Body (church member) as you are baptized by immersion in water as a follower of Jesus.
- 3. Have you already given your life to Christ and been obedient to follow Him in baptism but still need to connect to a church family? Let's schedule a time to make sure you are clear on the Gospel, hear your testimony, and answer any lingering questions, then we'll set a day to present you to the church to be welcomed as a part of the Body (church member) by your statement of faith or by move from a likeminded church.
- 4. Or, maybe you just need more time and have more questions to process. That's great! Let us know so we can follow up with you and help you understand more what it means to trust and follow Jesus.
